

# The Rules for Draws for Medal Competitions

In 2014 a “Soft Draw” will be in place for mens medal competitions at the weekend (excluding the TARLOGIE, ROSE & MACLEOD and the CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP). For all Thursday medals the time you book online will be your exact tee time (apart from the Midsummer Tournament which will be a random draw). For the 3 competitions named above there will be a full draw (random apart from the Club Championship which will be seeded by handicap). Sunday competitions will not be affected.

The procedures for a Soft Draw are as follows

- Members wishing to play in the competition will enter their names in half hour time slots within the designated competition booked tee times.
- The competition tee times will be as follows but may be adjusted by the Committee dependent on weather, the time of year and demand
  - 7:30 to 10:00
  - 1:00 to 2:00
  - 15:00 to 15:20
  - 16:30 to 17.00Subject to advance bookings
- No competition entry will be permitted out with the competition tee times
- Competitors should present themselves at the pro shop at least 10 minutes prior to the first time of the half hour slot e.g. by 7:20 for the 7:30 slot. The professional or designated assistant will “draw” the cards for playing partners and allocation of the tee times. It is their decision on whether draws are in 2 or 3 per tee time.
- Members wishing to play but who have not entered their name on the draw sheet should present themselves at the pro shop as above and will be entered in the draw for that time slot space permitting. If there is no space they will be automatically moved to the half hour slot until they can be fitted in.
